Office: Help as needed to organize, list, mail etc.

Trunk or Treat: This project was devised by PSR parents to give their children an experience of fun at St. Nicholas – not just church.

Saturday, October 27 trick-or-treating is done at church on the parking lot after the 5:00 liturgy and dinner. Help is needed in the kitchen wrapping hot dogs, arranging the parking lot, setting up, decorating and cleaning up. Typically, we are cleaned up and home by 8:00.

Grade Level Service or Liturgical Project: Once a year effort to support classroom projects. 3rd and 4th grade enactment of Palm Sunday, 5th grade - Rosary, 6th grade - Christmas play, 7th grade - Stations of the Cross and Thanksgiving food preparation. This is an assistance role not in charge.

Teen Volunteer: High school students willing to assist in the classroom by making up games for class review, listening to prayers, assisting a special needs child, willing to share insights into faith and living the Christian life are needed in various grades.
